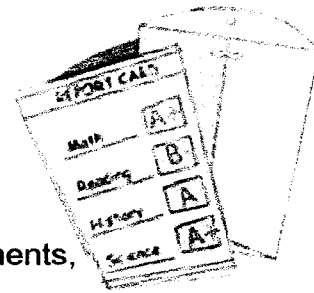
My Rules

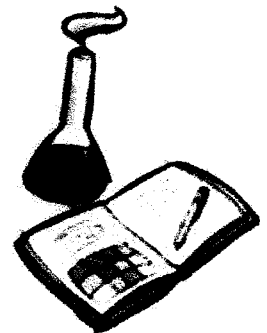
