## Class Guidelines:

**Grades:** 80% tests/quizzes/labs/projects

### **Math:**

1. First night of new lesson- homework from book-checked in class
2. Second night of lesson-homework from worksheet-for grade
3. Quiz after 2 lessons \*Check planners for quiz day
4. Test on Chapter \*Check planners for test day
5. Lunch time: help when needed/ must ask first to stay in  
(only on Mon. Tues. Thurs.)

### **Science:**

1. Students are to take notes in class. Checked on day of test.
2. Vocabulary is to be completed the night of the test for the next chapter. (may have finished after test)
