How strong is OLP? As alumni you would be proud to know that we have received the National Innovations in Catholic Education Award for three consecutive terms and we are one of only two schools in the country to do so!

For more than 10 years OLP has earned the highest score in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston on the eighth grade ACRE (religion assessment) and our fifth graders have continued to finish in the top three in the diocese those same years.

While all of these and other accolades make the school stand out on paper, it is what the students and staff are learning and doing that make Our Lady of Peace shine! Students in grades 7-8 perform 50 hours of community service on their own in addition to the community service projects they do as a class, school, or parish. Our students attend adoration, lead Mass each week, excel in the classroom, work hard in athletics, and learn values and morals that encourage them to have high standards and strong self-esteem.

We thank each of you for your gifts of time, talent, and treasure; and thank you especially for your prayers. Together we are PEACE!
