

SNOW DAY ALERT
PLEASE POST ON YOUR REFRIGERATOR!

Dear Parents,

The long range winter forecast can look questionable. We need to be prepared. To keep our families informed, I send this schedule of our Snow Day Policy. **Please post this note in a convenient place for your quick reference.**

WEATHER CLOSING:

If **EITHER** Ohio or Marshall County **closes** because of snow or ice, OLP classes are most likely cancelled. A Parent Alert will be sent to inform you of changes. Information will also be shared through WTRF-7 and WTOV-9 Weather Alerts. **Note:** *Exceptions can be made to this, and we may operate on a 2-hour delay.*

WEATHER DELAY:

Regular Classes:

If either or both counties delay because of snow or ice, we will most likely delay, and classes will begin at 10:00AM for K thru 8. **Teachers report by 9:00** or appropriate time for early AM class.

Parents, you may drop off your student/s beginning at 9:00 AM in early morning duty.

PK4 Classes:

If either or both counties delay, classes are as follows:

PK4 All Day: 10:00AM to 3:00PM (Lunch at noon)

PK4 Half Day: 10:00AM to Noon

Parents may drop off PK4 students in early morning duty care. Mrs. Hunnell will open her doors at 9:45 for classroom daily start time.

PK 3 Classes:

If either or both counties delay, classes are as follows:

PK3: 10:00 to Noon

PK3: 1:00 to 3:00

Special Classes

Algebra with Mrs. Schlanz: If either or both counties delay, classes begin at 9:00 AM.

Early Morning Duty in gym begins at 9:00. Teachers pick up class at 9:45.

Please be listening for **PARENT ALERT** for all details. There **may** be times that WE DO NOT FOLLOW the county schedules if there have been too many snow days, if the weather would allow for a delay instead of closing, or if only cold weather is a factor.

Therefore, it is very important that you listen to your Parent Alert message. I will keep you up-to-date with calendar changes as they occur.
